Summary:

This bill would revise provisions of the Nebraska Political Accountability and Disclosure Act relating to candidate financial disclosures. Under current statute, real estate holdings are among assets that must be disclosed by candidates in their "statement of financial interest" report. This bill would clarify any real estate used as a residence by the individual subject to the reporting requirement is within an existing exception for "the residence of the individual."
