**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

Summary:

This bill would require that county historical associations or societies make an accounting to the county board of funds received from the three mill levy authorized for such organizations. This accounting to the board would be made via a written report and a presentation at a public meeting of the board. Associations and societies that failed to make this report within one calendar year of receiving funding would be ineligible to receive further funding until they completed the accounting requirement. This bill also clarifies that such associations and societies are subject to the oversight of the Auditor of Public Accounts.
