**Summary of purpose and/or changes:**

LB 983 would modify the powers granted to certain political subdivisions relating to the promotion and management of industrial development. It would exclude from the definition of "industry" any enterprises providing services relating to the storage of personal property. It would also provide that the burden of proving a particular tract use is on the owners of the tract.
