Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

This bill would prohibit possession of a deadly weapon by the subject of a foreign protection order.

Possession of a deadly weapon which is not a firearm by a prohibited person is a Class III felony (Maximum — four years imprisonment and two years post-release supervision or twenty-five thousand dollars fine, or both; Minimum — none for imprisonment and nine months post-release supervision if imprisonment is imposed).

Possession of a deadly weapon which is a firearm by a prohibited person is a Class ID felony for the first offense (Maximum — fifty years imprisonment; Mandatory minimum — three years imprisonment). For subsequent offenses, it is a Class IB felony (Maximum — life imprisonment; Minimum — twenty years imprisonment).

The Department of Correctional Services (DCS) notes that this bill could increase the prison population, but the impact is unknown.

If the impact of this bill is to increase the prison population by more than current law, then this could have an impact on prison overcrowding. The average daily prison population was 145% of design capacity as of December 2020.

If the impact of this bill is to increase the prison population, then DCS could incur additional per diem costs. The FY20 per diem cost for an individual inmate was \$10,180 per year, which includes DCS inmates in county jails.

The Class III felony penalty also carries the possibility of a fine being imposed. Any fines assessed pursuant to convictions will accrue to the county where the violation occurs to be used for the support of public schools.

The Supreme Court and the Nebraska State Patrol estimate no fiscal impact from this bill.
