LB29, as amended by AM 1610, would retain Arbor Day as a State holiday and would add Juneteenth to the list of State holidays as accordance to law which established Juneteenth as a federal holiday.

If the bill was passed as introduced, DAS-Employee Relations states the agency would negotiate agreements with all four labor unions, NAPE, FOP, SLEBC and SCATA, to make the necessary adjustments to the labor contract.

The amendment, AM 2390, inserts the language "National Independence Day" after "Juneteenth". The amendment also includes an emergency clause.

LB 29 has no fiscal impact.

Explanation of Estin	nate:			

The legislation as amended adds a State Holiday in June (Juneteenth), which would align with the Federal holiday schedule. This action results in much of our Park staff still required to work, as it is within the busy summer camping season. The result is an increase in PSL costs as daily staff requirements affect Overtime pay and compensatory time earned.

Using 70% of the 2017-2020 4-year average staffing figures from Independence Day, (as only moderate increases in camping are expected), an increase of 580 staffing hours would be expected. At the average 2020 cost per hour of Overtime pay (\$26.31), this would be an additional \$15,259.80 in staff wages for the current year. An estimated 2% increase would occur for the following fiscal period. The only Benefit affected would be the State match to Retirement contributions, net of 7.488% of wages.

The Nebraska Game and Parks Commission would make internal adjustments to compensate for the additional wages needed.
