The bill's legislative intent is to group professional staff employee classifications, to include the managerial-professional and managerial employee classification, in broad occupational units within the University of Nebraska and the Nebraska state colleges on a university-wide or college-system-wide basis, unless otherwise pursuant to the Industrial Relations Act. The proposed changes would have a start date of August 1, 2021. The bill contains an emergency clause.

LB 660 has no fiscal impact on the University of Nebraska or Nebraska state colleges.
