Any Fiscal Notes received from state agencies and political subdivisions are attached following the Legislative Fiscal Analyst Estimate.

LB 660 relates the State Employees Collective Bargaining Act. The bill's legislative intent is to group professional staff employee classifications, to include the managerial-professional and managerial employee classification, in broad occupational units within the University of Nebraska and the Nebraska state colleges on a university-wide or college-system-wide basis, unless otherwise pursuant to the Industrial Relations Act. The proposed changes would have a start date of **August 1, 2021.** The bill contains an emergency clause.

LB 660 has no fiscal impact on the University of Nebraska or Nebraska state colleges. However, it is unclear whether the language would require existing bargaining units to restructure, and if so, the change may result in additional cost to the NSCS.
