## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 336**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Game Law; to amend section 37-438,
- 2 Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement, 2020; to change certain
- 3 fees; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 37-438, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2020, is amended to read:

3 37-438 (1) The commission shall devise annual, temporary, and
4 disabled veteran permits.

5 (2) The annual permit may be purchased by any person and shall be valid through December 31 in the year for which the permit is issued. The 6 7 fee for the annual permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be not more than thirty-five dollars per permit. The fee for the annual permit for a 8 9 nonresident motor vehicle shall not be two times less than the fee for a resident motor vehicle or sixty and not more than sixty-five dollars, 10 whichever is greater. The commission shall establish such fees by the 11 adoption and promulgation of rules and regulations. 12

13 (3) A temporary permit may be purchased by any person and shall be valid until noon of the day following the date of issue. The fee for the 14 temporary permit for a resident motor vehicle shall be not more than 15 16 seven dollars. The fee for the temporary permit for a nonresident motor vehicle shall be two times the fee for a resident motor vehicle or not 17 more than twelve dollars, whichever is greater. The commission shall 18 establish such fees by the adoption and promulgation of rules and 19 regulations. The commission may issue temporary permits which are either 20 valid for any area or valid for a single area. 21

(4)(a) A veteran who is a resident of Nebraska shall, upon
application and without payment of any fee, be issued one disabled
veteran permit for a resident motor vehicle if the veteran:

(i) Was discharged or separated with a characterization of honorable
or general (under honorable conditions); and

(ii)(A) Is rated by the United States Department of Veterans Affairs
as fifty percent or more disabled as a result of service in the armed
forces of the United States; or

30 (B) Is receiving a pension from the United States Department of31 Veterans Affairs as a result of total and permanent disability, which

1 disability was not incurred in the line of duty in the military service.

(b) All disabled veteran permits issued pursuant to this subsection
shall be perpetual and shall become void only upon termination of
eligibility as provided in this subsection.

5 (c) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations6 necessary to carry out this subsection.

7 (5) The commission may offer permits or combinations of permits at
8 temporarily reduced rates for specific events or during specified
9 timeframes.

Sec. 2. Original section 37-438, Revised Statutes Cumulative
 Supplement, 2020, is repealed.
