Section 1. Section 80-901, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

80-901 Any Nebraska resident who is <u>a</u> an enlisted member of a

Nebraska-based unit of the Active Selected Reserve of the armed forces of

the United States, who meets the requirements set forth in section 80-902

6 and complies with section 80-903, and who enrolls in any state-supported

7 <u>university, college, or community college in this state shall be entitled</u>

8 <u>to a credit of (1) seventy-five percent of the resident tuition charges</u>

9 <u>of such school for a diploma, certificate, associate degree, or</u>

10 <u>baccalaureate degree program or (2) fifty percent of the resident tuition</u>

11 charges of such school for a graduate or professional degree program. $_{ au}$

on or after July 10, 1976, in any state-supported university or college,

13 including any community college, shall be entitled to a credit of fifty

14 percent of the tuition charges of such university or college. Such

entitlement shall be continuous so long as the member maintains

19 Sec. 2. Section 80-902, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 20 amended to read:

80-902 (1) In order to qualify for the tuition credit provided for 21 22 in section 80-901, a member of the Active Selected Reserve shall (1) be 23 classified as enlisted personnel who have a minimum of two years 24 remaining on their enlistment at the commencement of each term in their 25 respective courses of study, (2) have agreed to serve a minimum of three years in the reserve, (3) not have completed his tenth year of total 26 27 service in the armed forces of the United States, and (4) pursue a course to a <u>diploma</u>, <u>certificate</u>, <u>associate degree</u>, 28 of study leading baccalaureate degree, graduate degree, or professional degree degree or 29 the equivalent level of study in a community college, and his entitlement 30 to such credit shall cease upon the attainment of such degree or 31

- 2 (2) There shall be no lifetime limit on tuition credit for any
- 3 qualifying member.
- 4 (3) Such entitlement shall not be granted to more than two hundred
- 5 individuals in any calendar year.
- 6 Sec. 3. Section 80-903, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 8 80-903 It shall be the responsibility of the individual member of
- 9 the Active Selected Reserve to obtain a certificate from the member's his
- 10 commanding officer attesting to the member's his satisfactory performance
- 11 and to submit it to the Director of Veterans' Affairs who, if finding he
- 12 finds that granting the entitlement will not exceed the limitation of new
- 13 entitlements provided in section 80-902, shall endorse the certificate of
- 14 performance as approved and return it to the member for presentation to
- 15 the college or university in order to obtain tuition credit upon initial
- 16 enrollment. Such certification, without the necessity of endorsement by
- 17 the Director of Veterans' Affairs, shall be accomplished and presented at
- 18 the time of enrollment for each subsequent term for which tuition credit
- 19 is requested.
