- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to home inspectors; to define terms; to
- 2 require registration with the Secretary of State; to provide for a
- 3 fee; to require proof of financial responsibility; to provide a
- 4 penalty; to provide for rules and regulations; and to provide an
- 5 operative date.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

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- 1 Section 1. For purposes of sections 1 to 6 of this act:
- 2 (1) Home inspection means the process by which a home inspector
- 3 <u>examines the observable systems and components of improvements to</u>
- 4 residential real property that are readily accessible to such inspector;
- 5 (2) Home inspector means a person who, for compensation, conducts a
- 6 home inspection; and
- 7 (3) Residential real property means a structure used or intended to
- 8 <u>be used as a residence and consisting of one to four family dwelling</u>
- 9 units.
- 10 Sec. 2. Before conducting home inspections in this state and in
- 11 each even-numbered year, a home inspector shall register with the
- 12 <u>Secretary of State. If the home inspector is an individual, the home</u>
- 13 inspector shall sign such registration. If the home inspector is a firm,
- 14 partnership, corporation, company, association, limited liability
- 15 company, or other legal entity, an officer or agent of the home inspector
- 16 shall sign such registration. Such registration shall include:
- 17 (1) The name of the home inspector if the home inspector is an
- 18 individual or the name of the legal entity under which such home
- 19 <u>inspector proposes to register and transact business in this state;</u>
- 20 (2) The address of the home office of the home inspector;
- 21 (3) The name and address of the agent for service of process on the
- 22 home inspector; and
- 23 (4) Any national certification relating to home inspection currently
- 24 held by the home inspector.
- 25 Sec. 3. At the time of registration pursuant to section 2 of this
- 26 act, a home inspector shall:
- 27 <u>(1) Pay a registration fee to the Secretary of State. The Secretary</u>
- 28 of State shall set such registration fee in an amount sufficient to
- 29 defray the administrative costs of registration but not to exceed three
- 30 hundred dollars. The Secretary of State shall remit such registration fee
- 31 to the State Treasurer for credit to the Secretary of State Cash Fund;

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- 1 <u>and</u>
- 2 (2) Provide to the Secretary of State a certificate of insurance
- 3 <u>evidencing coverage in an amount of not less than two hundred fifty</u>
- 4 thousand dollars for general liability.
- 5 Sec. 4. A home inspector shall report a change in information
- 6 required by section 2 or 3 of this act within thirty business days of
- 7 <u>such change.</u>
- 8 Sec. 5. Any violation of sections 2 to 4 of this act shall be a
- 9 Class IV misdemeanor.
- Sec. 6. The Secretary of State may adopt and promulgate rules and
- 11 <u>regulations to carry out sections 1 to 6 of this act.</u>
- 12 Sec. 7. This act becomes operative on January 1, 2023.
