- 2 Revised Statutes Supplement, 2021; to extend the commercial air
- 3 filter pilot program; and to repeal the original section.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 79-10,110.03, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2021,
 is amended to read:

3 79-10,110.03 (1) The State Department of Education shall develop and 4 implement a pilot program to study the efficacy of commercial air filters 5 in classrooms to remove common pollutants and particulate matter and 6 their impact on academic and behavioral performance.

(2) It is the intent of the Legislature that:

8 (a) The pilot program development and implementation be completed in
9 consultation with the University of Nebraska;

(b) The study be <u>three</u> two years in duration over school years
 2021-22, and 2022-23, and 2023-24;

(c) The pilot program include fifty participating schools with six
 participating classrooms in each participating school;

(d) Participating schools voluntarily agree to participate in thepilot program;

(e) Participating classrooms be used to educate students in any
 grade between, and including, grades 3 through 8;

18 (f) No more than fifty percent of participating schools be selected 19 from the same school district; and

20 (g) Fifty percent of the participating classrooms be randomly21 assigned to the control group.

(3) Upon conclusion of the pilot program, the department shall
electronically report the results to the Clerk of the Legislature and to
the Education Committee of the Legislature.

(4) The State Board of Education may adopt and promulgate rules andregulations to carry out this section.

Sec. 2. Original section 79-10,110.03, Revised Statutes Supplement,
28 2021, is repealed.
