## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1012**

Introduced by Speaker Hilgers, 21; at the request of the Governor.

Read first time January 13, 2022

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to amend section 55-801,
- 2 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide for transfers of
- funds; to create funds; to change provisions relating to use of a
- 4 fund; to eliminate provisions regarding state agency postage
- 5 reimbursement; to repeal the original section; to outright repeal
- 6 section 81-167, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; and to declare
- 7 an emergency.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$500,000 from the
- 2 General Fund to the Community College State Dependents Fund on or before
- 3 April 30, 2022, on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the
- 4 budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 5 Administrative Services.
- 6 Sec. 2. The State Treasurer shall transfer \$1,000,000 from the
- 7 General Fund to the Community College State Dependents Fund on July 1,
- 8 2022, or as soon thereafter as administratively possible, as directed by
- 9 the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of
- 10 Administrative Services.
- Sec. 3. <u>The Community College State Dependents Fund is created. The</u>
- 12 fund shall be used to reimburse tuition expenses for dependents of
- 13 Nebraska state employees enrolled in one of the state's six community
- 14 colleges. The Department of Administrative Services shall administer the
- 15 fund through the benefits administration program. The fund shall consist
- 16 of transfers authorized by the Legislature and any gifts, grants, or
- 17 bequests for such purposes from any source, including federal, state,
- 18 public, and private sources. Any money in the fund available for
- 19 investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to
- 20 <u>the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds</u>
- 21 <u>Investment Act.</u>
- 22 Sec. 4. The Statewide Tourism And Recreational Water Access and
- 23 Resource Sustainability Fund is created. The fund shall be administered
- 24 by the Department of Natural Resources. The State Treasurer shall credit
- 25 to the fund any money transferred by the Legislature and such grants,
- 26 <u>loans, donations, gifts, bequests, or other money received from any</u>
- 27 federal or state agency or public or private source for water and
- 28 recreational projects authorized by the Legislature. Any money in the
- 29 fund available for investment shall be invested by the state investment
- 30 officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska
- 31 State Funds Investment Act. Any investment earnings from investment of

- 1 money in the fund shall be credited to the fund.
- Sec. 5. (1) The Perkins County Canal Project Fund is created. The
- 3 fund shall be administered by the Department of Natural Resources. The
- 4 State Treasurer shall credit to the fund any money transferred by the
- 5 Legislature and such grants, loans, donations, gifts, bequests, or other
- 6 money received from any federal or state agency or public or private
- 7 source for use by the department for the canal project.
- 8 (2) After the Director of Natural Resources certifies the completion
- 9 of the Perkins County Canal Project to the budget administrator of the
- 10 budget division of the Department of Administrative Services, the State
- 11 <u>Treasurer shall transfer any money remaining in the Perkins County Canal</u>
- 12 <u>Project Fund to the Cash Reserve Fund.</u>
- 13 (3) Any money in the Perkins County Canal Project Fund available for
- 14 <u>investment shall be invested by the state investment officer pursuant to</u>
- 15 the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act and the Nebraska State Funds
- 16 Investment Act. Any investment earnings from investment of money in the
- 17 fund shall be credited to the fund.
- 18 Sec. 6. Section 55-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 19 amended to read:
- 20 55-801 The United States Space Command Headquarters Assistance Fund
- 21 is created. The fund shall be used to contribute to the support and
- 22 profile of the Strategic Air Command and Offutt Air Force Base in
- 23 Bellevue, Nebraska construction of the United States Space Command
- 24 headquarters if the State of Nebraska is selected as the site for the
- 25 headquarters. The Adjutant General of the State of Nebraska shall
- 26 administer the fund. The fund shall consist of transfers authorized by
- 27 the Legislature and any gifts, grants, or bequests from any source,
- 28 including federal, state, public, and private sources, for such purposes.
- 29 Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the
- 30 state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act
- 31 and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.

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1 Sec. 7. Original section 55-801, Reissue Revised Statutes of

- 2 Nebraska, is repealed.
- 3 Sec. 8. The following section is outright repealed: Section 81-167,
- 4 Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska.
- 5 Sec. 9. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 6 passed and approved according to law.
