## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1074**

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to irrigation districts; to amend section
- 2 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2021; to create a fund; to
- 3 create a grant program; to provide powers and duties to the
- 4 Department of Natural Resources; to provide for a transfer of funds;
- 5 and to repeal the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. There is hereby created the Surface Water Irrigation
- 2 <u>Infrastructure Fund to be administered by the Department of Natural</u>
- 3 Resources. The fund shall be used to provide grants in accordance with
- 4 section 2 of this act to irrigation districts. There shall be a one-time
- 5 transfer of fifty million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the
- 6 Surface Water Irrigation Infrastructure Fund to carry out the purposes of
- 7 section 2 of this act. Any money in the Surface Water Irrigation
- 8 <u>Infrastructure Fund available for investment shall be invested by the</u>
- 9 <u>state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act</u>
- 10 and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- 11 Sec. 2. <u>The Department of Natural Resources shall establish</u>
- 12 procedures and criteria for awarding grants to irrigation districts from
- 13 the Surface Water Irrigation Infrastructure Fund to be used for repair or
- 14 construction of any headgate, flume, diversion structure, check valve, or
- 15 any other physical structure used for irrigation projects. The department
- 16 <u>may award grants, not to exceed five million dollars per applicant, to an</u>
- 17 irrigation district that applies to the department based on criteria and
- 18 procedures established by the department. In order to receive a grant
- 19 under this section, a grant applicant shall provide matching funds equal
- 20 <u>to ten percent of the grant amount awarded for such project.</u>
- 21 Sec. 3. Section 84-612, Revised Statutes Supplement, 2021, is
- 22 amended to read:
- 23 84-612 (1) There is hereby created within the state treasury a fund
- 24 known as the Cash Reserve Fund which shall be under the direction of the
- 25 State Treasurer. The fund shall only be used pursuant to this section.
- 26 (2) The State Treasurer shall transfer funds from the Cash Reserve
- 27 Fund to the General Fund upon certification by the Director of
- 28 Administrative Services that the current cash balance in the General Fund
- 29 is inadequate to meet current obligations. Such certification shall
- 30 include the dollar amount to be transferred. Any transfers made pursuant
- 31 to this subsection shall be reversed upon notification by the Director of

- 1 Administrative Services that sufficient funds are available.
- 2 (3) In addition to receiving transfers from other funds, the Cash
- 3 Reserve Fund shall receive federal funds received by the State of
- 4 Nebraska for undesignated general government purposes, federal revenue
- 5 sharing, or general fiscal relief of the state.
- 6 (4) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty-four million seven
- 7 hundred thousand dollars on or after July 1, 2019, but before June 15,
- 8 2021, from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Nebraska Capital Construction
- 9 Fund on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget
- 10 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
- 11 Services.
- 12 (5) The State Treasurer shall transfer thirty million dollars from
- 13 the Cash Reserve Fund to the General Fund after November 15, 2020, but
- 14 before December 31, 2020, on such date as directed by the budget
- 15 administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative
- 16 Services. Except for the transfer authorized in this subsection, no funds
- 17 shall be transferred from the Cash Reserve Fund to fulfill the
- 18 obligations created under the Nebraska Property Tax Incentive Act unless
- 19 the balance in the Cash Reserve Fund after such transfer will be at least
- 20 equal to five hundred million dollars.
- 21 (6) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty million dollars from
- 22 the Cash Reserve Fund to the United States Space Command Headquarters
- 23 Assistance Fund on or before June 30, 2023, but not before July 1, 2022,
- 24 on such dates and in such amounts as directed by the budget administrator
- 25 of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services. The
- 26 transfer in this subsection shall not occur unless the State of Nebraska
- 27 is selected as the site of the United States Space Command headquarters.
- 28 <u>(7) The State Treasurer shall transfer fifty million dollars from</u>
- 29 the Cash Reserve Fund to the Surface Water Irrigation Infrastructure Fund
- 30 on or after July 1, 2022, but before January 1, 2023, on such date and in
- 31 such amounts as directed by the budget administrator of the budget
