- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
- funds to the State Department of Education; to declare legislative
- intent to appropriate funds; and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that:
- 2 (a) The COVID-19 public health emergency greatly impacted Nebraska's
- 3 young people, resulting in lost instructional time for students, lost
- 4 opportunities to conduct fundraising events, and lost educational
- 5 capacity;
- 6 (b) There is a dire workforce need for health-science professionals,
- 7 educators, skilled tradespeople, and support in related fields caused by
- 8 the COVID-19 public health emergency; and
- 9 <u>(c) Support for career and technical education programs as an</u>
- 10 extension of the classroom for real-world learning experience in middle
- 11 <u>and high schools is critical.</u>
- 12 (2) There is hereby appropriated \$5,000,000 from Federal Funds for
- 13 FY2022-23 to the State Department of Education for the purpose of
- 14 carrying out the Center for Student Leadership and Expanded Learning Act
- 15 and for career and technical educational student organizations. The
- 16 Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds allocated
- 17 <u>to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal</u>
- 18 Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021,
- 19 Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 20 (3) It is the intent of the Legislature:
- 21 (a) To appropriate \$1,300,000 from the General Fund each fiscal year
- 22 beginning in FY2022-23 for administration of the Center for Student
- 23 Leadership and Expanded Learning Act; and
- 24 (b) That expenditures may be made from such future appropriations
- 25 for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems for state employees.
- Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 27 passed and approved according to law.
