## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1087**

Committee: Appropriations

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
- funds for aid to community colleges; and to declare an emergency.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1)(a) There is hereby appropriated \$15,000,000 from
- 2 <u>Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to Program No. 151 Aid to Community</u>
- 3 Colleges. The Federal Funds appropriated in this subsection are from the
- 4 funds allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus
- 5 State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan
- 6 Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 7 (b) There is included in the appropriation to this program for
- 8 FY2022-23 \$15,000,000 Federal Funds for state aid for dual enrollment,
- 9 which shall only be used for such purpose.
- 10 (c) The funds appropriated in this section for dual enrollment shall
- 11 <u>be distributed to community college areas in direct proportion to the</u>
- 12 <u>full-time-equivalent enrollment in dual credit courses delivered by the</u>
- 13 <u>respective community college areas based upon dual enrollment credit hour</u>
- 14 data reported to the Coordinating Commission for Postsecondary Education
- 15 by the respective community college areas for the year in which those
- 16 enrollments occurred.
- 17 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature that the funds appropriated
- 18 in this section be expended by the respective community college areas in
- 19 <u>the following manner:</u>
- 20 (a) \$5,000,000 in FY2022-23;
- 21 (b) \$5,000,000 in FY2023-24; and
- 22 (c) \$5,000,000 in FY2024-25.
- 23 (3) For purposes of this section, dual enrollment course means a
- 24 course delivered to high school students for whom credit shall be
- 25 reported on the student's postsecondary educational institution
- 26 <u>transcript</u>. It is the intent of the Legislature that amounts distributed
- 27 <u>to each community college area in proportion to enrollment in dual</u>
- 28 enrollment courses be applied to support discounting of tuition assessed
- 29 <u>for enrollment in such courses.</u>
- 30 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 31 passed and approved according to law.
