- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
- funds to the Department of Economic Development; and to declare an
- 3 emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature hereby finds and declares that
- 2 <u>health-outcome disparities arose from the COVID-19 public health</u>
- 3 <u>emergency</u>. To <u>limit</u> such health-outcome disparities, as recognized in the
- 4 federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M,
- 5 Sec. 6001, the production of clean, zero-carbon energy through the use of
- 6 advanced nuclear technology would be beneficial to public health.
- 7 (2) There is hereby appropriated \$1,000,000 from Federal Funds for
- 8 FY2022-23 to the Department of Economic Development for the purposes
- 9 described in subsection (3) of this section. The Federal Funds
- 10 appropriated in this section are from the funds allocated to the State of
- 11 Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant
- 12 <u>to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2,</u>
- 13 <u>Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.</u>
- 14 (3) In order to comply with the requirements for use of funds
- 15 allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State
- 16 Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 17 2021 and to address health-outcome disparities from the COVID-19 public
- 18 health emergency, the funds appropriated in this section shall only be
- 19 used by a political subdivision that owns or operates a nuclear plant in
- 20 Nebraska. Such political subdivision shall use the funds appropriated in
- 21 this section to conduct a feasibility study to assess (a) siting options
- 22 for new advanced nuclear reactors throughout Nebraska and (b) existing
- 23 <u>electric generation facilities based on key compatibility assets for such</u>
- 24 advanced nuclear reactors.
- 25 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 26 passed and approved according to law.
