## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 1166**

  amend sections 76-2324 and 76-2329, Reissue Revised Statutes of
  Nebraska; to change provisions relating to liability for damage by
  an excavator; to harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original
  sections.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 76-2324, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 76-2324 (1) An excavator who fails to give notice of an excavation pursuant to section 76-2321 or who fails to comply with section 76-2331 4 5 and who damages an underground facility by such excavation shall be strictly liable to the operator of the underground facility for the cost 6 of all repairs to the underground facility, except that such excavator 7 shall not be strictly liable to the operator for the cost of all repairs 8 to any underground facility that is a telecommunications line on 9 residential property buried at a distance of twelve inches or more from a 10 building and at a depth of less than ten inches. An excavator who gives 11 the notice and who damages an underground facility shall be liable to the 12 operator for the cost of all repairs to the underground facility unless 13 14 the damage to the underground facility was due to the operator's failure to comply with section 76-2323. An excavator who fails to give notice of 15 an excavation pursuant to section 76-2321 and who damages an underground 16 facility that is operated by the excavator shall not be in violation of 17 the One-Call Notification System Act. For purposes of this subsection, 18 telecommunications line means any electronic communications, telephonic 19 communications, telegraphic communications, or cable television 20 underground facility, including, but not limited to, fiber optic cables. 21

22 <u>(2)</u> In addition to any liability provided in this section an 23 operator of a damaged underground facility shall be entitled to any other 24 remedies available at law or in equity provided by statute or otherwise.

25 Sec. 2. Section 76-2329, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is 26 amended to read:

27 76-2329 (1) Sections 76-2321 and 76-2323 shall not apply to an 28 excavation made under an emergency condition if all reasonable 29 precautions are taken to protect the underground facilities. If an 30 emergency condition exists, the excavator shall give notification in 31 substantial compliance with section 76-2321 as soon as practical. Upon

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1 being notified that an emergency condition exists, each operator shall 2 provide all reasonably available location information to the excavator as soon as possible. If the emergency condition has arisen through no fault 3 of the excavator, sections 76-2324 and 76-2325 shall not apply and the 4 5 excavator shall be liable for damage to any underground facility located in the area, except for damage to any telecommunications line buried on 6 7 residential property as described in subsection (1) of section 76-2324, if the damage occurs because of the negligent acts or omissions of the 8 9 excavator.

10 (2) Sections 76-2321 and 76-2323 shall not apply to a bar test survey deemed necessary to address an emergency condition performed by 11 the operator of the gas or hazardous liquid underground pipeline facility 12 13 or a qualified excavator who has been engaged to work on behalf of the operator in response to a reported or suspected leak of natural gas, 14 propane, or other combustible liquid or gas. If the emergency condition 15 16 has arisen through no fault of the excavating operator, section 76-2325 17 shall not apply.

(3) Sections 76-2321 and 76-2323 shall not apply to an excavation 18 deemed necessary to address an emergency condition performed by the 19 operator of the gas or hazardous liquid underground pipeline facility or 20 a qualified excavator who has been engaged to work on behalf of the 21 operator to address a leak of natural gas, propane, or other combustible 22 23 liquid or gas. In such event, the operator shall give notification in 24 substantial compliance with section 76-2321 prior to the excavation 25 undertaken by the operator to address the emergency condition. Upon being notified that an emergency condition exists, each operator shall provide 26 all reasonably available location information to the excavating operator 27 28 as soon as possible, but the excavating operator need not wait for such location information prior to excavation or continuing excavation. If the 29 emergency condition has arisen through no fault of the excavating 30 31 operator, section 76-2325 shall not apply.
