- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to adopt the School Employees
- 2 Pandemic Protection Act; and to state intent regarding appropriation
- 3 of federal funds.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 5 of this act shall be known and may be

- 2 <u>cited as the School Employees Pandemic Protection Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. For purposes of the School Employees Pandemic Protection
- 4 Act:
- 5 (1) Personal protective equipment means any equipment worn or used
- 6 to minimize exposure to hazards that cause serious workplace illnesses,
- 7 <u>including</u>, but not limited to, face masks, face shields, gloves,
- 8 plexiglass barriers, COVID-19 tests, and hand sanitizer; and
- 9 (2) School employee means an individual employed by a school,
- 10 including, but not limited to, teachers, paraeducators, administrators,
- 11 <u>and food service and transportation personnel.</u>
- 12 Sec. 3. On or before August 1, 2022, the State Department of
- 13 Education shall create the School Employees Pandemic Protection Program.
- 14 The purpose of the program is to ensure that each school employee
- 15 receives a payment, in an amount not to exceed two hundred dollars, to
- 16 cover the expense of personal protective equipment purchased by a school
- 17 employee. The payment shall be paid out of the School Employees Pandemic
- 18 Protection Fund.
- 19 Sec. 4. The School Employees Pandemic Protection Fund is created.
- 20 The fund shall be administered by the State Department of Education. The
- 21 fund shall consist of funds appropriated or transferred by the
- 22 Legislature and any gifts, grants, bequests, or donations to the fund.
- 23 Any money in the fund available for investment shall be invested by the
- 24 state investment officer pursuant to the Nebraska Capital Expansion Act
- 25 and the Nebraska State Funds Investment Act.
- Sec. 5. <u>It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate</u>
- 27 \$10,000,000 from Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the State Department of
- 28 Education to implement the School Employees Pandemic Protection Program.
- 29 The Federal Funds shall be from the funds allocated to the State of
- 30 Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant
- 31 to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law 117-2,
