- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to state intent regarding
- 2 appropriations of federal funds to the Department of Health and
- 3 Human Services; to define terms; and to declare an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) The Legislature finds and declares that:
- 2 (a) Nebraska's seven federally qualified health centers are
- 3 nonprofit, community-based organizations that provide comprehensive high-
- 4 quality primary care and preventive care, including medical, dental,
- 5 <u>behavioral health</u>, and pharmacy services and support services to low-
- 6 income families, members of racial and ethnic minority groups, the
- 7 uninsured, and rural residents; and
- 8 <u>(b) The COVID-19 public health emergency has had a disproportionate</u>
- 9 <u>impact on Nebraskans who are served by federally qualified health</u>
- 10 centers.
- 11 (2) It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate \$25,000,000
- 12 Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the Department of Health and Human
- 13 Services, Program 502, Public Health Aid, to be distributed as grants as
- 14 provided in subsection (3) of this section to federally qualified health
- 15 centers as defined in Federal Program 330, Public Law 104-299, the
- 16 federal Health Centers Consolidation Act of 1996. The Federal Funds to be
- 17 appropriated under this section are from the funds allocated to the State
- 18 of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund
- 19 pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of 2021, Public Law
- 20 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 21 (3) The department shall distribute the funds as grants to federally
- 22 qualified health centers for costs associated with capital projects that
- 23 <u>will expand health care access to Nebraskans most impacted by the</u>
- 24 COVID-19 public health emergency. The grants shall be made to Charles
- 25 Drew Health Center, One World Community Health Center, East Central
- 26 <u>District Health Department Good Neighbor Community Health Center,</u>
- 27 <u>Community Action Partnership of Western Nebraska Health Center, Midtown</u>
- 28 Community Health Center, Bluestem Health, and Heartland Health Center.
- 29 (4) For purposes of this section:
- 30 (a) Capital project means a construction project to build, expand,
- 31 or develop a new or existing facility or facilities or restoration work

- 1 on a facility; and
- 2 (b) Cost, in the context of a capital project, means the cost of
- 3 <u>land</u>, <u>engineering</u>, <u>architectural</u> <u>planning</u>, <u>contract</u> <u>services</u>,
- 4 construction, materials, and equipment needed to complete the capital
- 5 project.
- 6 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when
- 7 passed and approved according to law.
