- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate federal
- funds to the Department of Health and Human Services; and to declare
- 3 an emergency.
- 4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. (1) There is hereby appropriated \$40,000,000 from
- 2 Federal Funds for FY2022-23 to the Department of Health and Human
- 3 Services for the purposes described in subsection (2) of this section.
- 4 The Federal Funds appropriated in this section are from the funds
- 5 <u>allocated to the State of Nebraska from the federal Coronavirus State</u>
- 6 Fiscal Recovery Fund pursuant to the federal American Rescue Plan Act of
- 7 2021, Public Law 117-2, Subtitle M, Sec. 9901.
- 8 (2)(a) The Department of Health and Human Services shall create a
- 9 program to award grants to nonprofit organizations in the following
- 10 manner:
- (i) \$20,000,000 shall be awarded to nonprofit organizations that
- 12 focus on food distribution in ten or more counties in the state and
- 13 qualifies for The Emergency Food Assistance Program administered by the
- 14 <u>United States Department of Agriculture. Funds awarded pursuant to this</u>
- 15 subdivision shall be used for the purchase and distribution of food,
- 16 infrastructure, and equipment and construction of increased capacity; and
- 17 (ii) \$20,000,000 shall be awarded for regional or local capacity and
- 18 <u>food security innovation grants to decrease Nebraska's reliance on</u>
- 19 <u>national supply chains, support local businesses, create local and</u>
- 20 regional economic resilience, encourage healthy eating habits, reduce
- 21 food deserts, and support partnerships between local businesses and
- 22 producers meeting the greatest needs statewide in the most efficient and
- 23 <u>sustainable manner.</u>
- 24 (b) The Department of Health and Human Services shall:
- (i) Create a process for soliciting, vetting, awarding, and
- 26 <u>monitoring grants; or</u>
- 27 <u>(ii) Contract with a third-party to solicit, vet, award, and monitor</u>
- 28 grants.
- 29 <u>(c) The program created pursuant to this section shall be</u>
- 30 coordinated and administered in compliance with the federal American
- 31 Rescue Plan Act of 2021.

1 Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when

2 passed and approved according to law.
