A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend sections 53-101 and 53-103, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to define a term; to require a licensed manufacturer, a licensed wholesaler, or a holder of a shipping license to submit a report and any applicable fees to the Nebraska Liquor Control Commission prior to the sale or shipment of any alcoholic liquor into the state; and to repeal the original sections.

- Sec. 3. (1) Primary source of supply in the United States means

- 12 <u>(a) Manufacturer, producer, or owner of any alcoholic liquor at the</u>
- 13 <u>time it becomes a marketable product;</u>
- 14 (b) Bottler of any alcoholic liquor in the United States; or
- 15 (c) Exclusive agent within the United States or any of the states of
- 16 <u>any manufacturer, producer, owner, or bottler of any alcoholic liquor</u>
- 17 outside the United States.
- 18 (2) To be the primary source of supply in the United States, the
- 19 licensee causing such alcoholic liquor to be imported into Nebraska must
- 20 be the first source, such as the manufacturer or the source closest to
- 21 the manufacturer, in the channel of commerce from which the product can
- 22 be secured by Nebraska licensed wholesalers.
- Sec. 4. (1)(a) Prior to the sale or shipment of any alcoholic
- 24 <u>liquor into the State of Nebraska, each licensed manufacturer,</u> licensed
- 25 wholesaler, or the holder of a shipping license, shall submit to the
- 26 <u>commission</u>, along with any applicable fees, a report on forms prescribed
- 27 and furnished by the commission, which shall include:
- 28 <u>(i) The licensee's name and license number;</u>
- 29 (ii) The designated Nebraska licensed wholesaler for such product,
- 30 <u>if applicable;</u>
- 31 (iii) The name of the primary source of supply in the United States;

- 1 (iv) The products to be imported, including the brand name, class or
- 2 type of product, and fanciful name if applicable;
- 3 (v) Evidence of compliance with federal label requirements pursuant
- 4 to the Federal Alcohol Administration Act 27 U.S.C., chapter 8, and rules
- 5 and regulations adopted pursuant to such act as such act and regulations
- existed on January 1, 2022; and 6
- 7 (vi) Any other information the commission may require related to
- such sale or shipment. 8
- (b) If the licensed manufacturer, licensed wholesaler, or the holder 9
- 10 of a shipping license is not the product manufacturer, such licensee
- shall also include with such form a separate letter from the product 11
- manufacturer in the United States designating such licensee as the 12
- 13 primary source of supply in the United States or the sole source of
- 14 supply in Nebraska. A separate letter is required for each primary
- 15 source.
- 16 (2) If the primary source of supply in the United States for such
- 17 alcoholic liquor changes, the new licensed manufacturer, licensed
- wholesaler, or holder of a shipping license importing such alcoholic 18
- 19 liquor shall submit the information required pursuant to subsection (1)
- of this section at least thirty days prior to the shipment of such 20
- alcoholic liquor into this state. The licensed manufacturer, licensed 21
- wholesaler, or holder of a shipping license shall also remit any 22
- applicable fees to the commission. 23
- 24 (3) The commission may adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to
- 25 carry out this section.
