- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act; to amend
- 2 section 53-123.14, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to define a
- 3 term; to change provisions relating to craft breweries; to allow for
- 4 self-distribution of beer under certain circumstances; and to repeal
- 5 the original section.
- 6 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 53-123.14, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska,

- 2 is amended to read:
- 3 53-123.14 (1) Any person who operates a craft brewery shall obtain
- 4 a license pursuant to the Nebraska Liquor Control Act. A license to
- 5 operate a craft brewery shall permit the production of a maximum of
- 6 twenty thousand barrels of beer per year in the aggregate from all
- 7 physical locations comprising the licensed premises. A craft brewery may
- 8 also sell to beer wholesalers for sale and distribution to licensed
- 9 retailers. A craft brewery license issued pursuant to this section shall
- 10 be the only license required by the Nebraska Liquor Control Act for the
- 11 manufacture and retail sale of beer for consumption on or off the
- 12 licensed premises, except that the sale of any beer other than beer
- 13 manufactured by the craft brewery licensee, wine, or alcoholic liquor by
- 14 the drink for consumption on the licensed premises shall require the
- 15 appropriate retail license. Any license held by the operator of a craft
- 16 brewery shall be subject to the act. A holder of a craft brewery license
- 17 may obtain an annual catering license pursuant to section 53-124.12, a
- 18 special designated license pursuant to section 53-124.11, an
- 19 entertainment district license pursuant to section 53-123.17, or a
- 20 promotional farmers market special designated license pursuant to section
- 21 53-124.16. For purposes of this section, licensed premises may include up
- 22 to five separate physical locations.
- 23 (2) Any brewer producing in aggregate less than five hundred barrels
- 24 of beer in a calendar year, whether directly or indirectly and whether
- 25 produced inside or outside Nebraska, may self-distribute its own beer
- 26 <u>brewed at its licensed brewery premises to a retail licensee if that</u>
- 27 brewer:
- 28 (a) Has not entered into a distribution agreement with a licensed
- 29 Nebraska wholesaler for the territory where such retail licensee is
- 30 located and has relinquished any retail license authorizing the brewer to
- 31 sell any alcohol not manufactured by the brewer;

- 1 (b) Self-distributes its beer utilizing only persons exclusively and
- 2 <u>solely employed by the brewer in vehicles exclusively and solely owned or</u>
- 3 <u>leased by the brewer;</u>
- 4 (c) Has obtained a Nebraska beer wholesale license, notwithstanding
- 5 sections 53-169, 53-169.01, and 53-171, after certifying under oath that
- 6 <u>it has produced in aggregate less than five hundred barrels of beer in</u>
- 7 such calendar year; and
- 8 (d) Complies with all relevant statutes, rules, and regulations that
- 9 apply to Nebraska beer wholesalers regarding distribution of such beer.
- 10 (3) A brewer obtaining a beer wholesale license to self-distribute
- 11 beer in accordance with subsection (2) of this section may only self-
- 12 <u>distribute beer brewed at its licensed brewery premises and shall not</u>
- 13 <u>distribute beer produced by any other licensee.</u>
- 14 (4) If a self-distributing brewer's production exceeds five hundred
- 15 barrels of beer prior to the end of a calendar year, the brewer may
- 16 continue to self-distribute its beer through December 31 of such year but
- 17 must relinquish its beer wholesale license thereafter and cease self-
- 18 distribution and distribute through another licensed Nebraska beer
- 19 wholesaler.
- 20 <u>(5) For purposes of this section, brewer means:</u>
- 21 (a) A holder of a craft brewery license or a license to produce or
- 22 <u>manufacture beer;</u>
- 23 (b) An officer, director, agent, or employee of such license holder;
- 24 and
- 25 (c) An affiliate of such license holder, regardless of whether such
- 26 <u>affiliation is corporate or by management, direction, or control.</u>
