- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Public Service Commission; to amend
- 2 section 75-126, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to provide an
- 3 unjust discrimination exception for common carriers as prescribed;
- 4 and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 75-126, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 75-126 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this section, no common
- 4 carrier shall:
- 5 (a) Charge, demand, collect, or receive from any person a greater or
- 6 lesser compensation for any services rendered than it charges, demands,
- 7 collects, or receives from any other person for doing a like or
- 8 contemporaneous service unless required under section 86-465;
- 9 (b) Make or give any undue or unreasonable preference or advantage
- 10 to any particular person;
- 11 (c) Subject any type of traffic to any undue or unreasonable
- 12 prejudice, delay, or disadvantage in any respect whatsoever;
- 13 (d) Charge or receive any greater compensation in the aggregate for
- 14 the transportation of a like kind of property or passengers for a shorter
- 15 than for a longer distance over the same line or route, except as the
- 16 commission may prescribe in special cases to prevent manifest injuries,
- 17 except that no manifest injustice shall be imposed upon any person at
- 18 intermediate points. This section shall not prevent the commission from
- 19 making group or emergency rates;
- 20 (e) Demand, charge, or collect, by any device whatsoever, a lesser
- 21 or greater compensation for any service rendered than that filed with or
- 22 prescribed by the commission; or
- 23 (f) Change any rate, schedule, or classification in any manner
- 24 whatsoever before application has been made to the commission and
- 25 permission granted for that purpose, except as otherwise provided in
- 26 section 86-155.
- 27 (2) This section shall not prohibit any common carrier from, and a
- 28 common carrier shall not be subject to any fine, penalty, or forfeiture
- 29 for, performing services free or at reduced rates to:
- 30 (a) The United States, the State of Nebraska, or any governmental
- 31 subdivision thereof;

- 1 (b) The employees, both present and retired, of such common carrier;
- 2 (c) Any person when the object is to provide relief in case of any
- 3 disaster;
- 4 (d) Any person who transports property for charitable purposes;
- 5 (e) Ministers and others giving their entire time to religious or
- 6 charitable work;—or
- 7 (f) Any person who is legally blind or visually handicapped; or -
- 8 (g) Any person who is sixty-five years of age or older.
