- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to law enforcement officers; to adopt the Law
- 2 Enforcement Attraction and Retention Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

| 1 | Section 1. <u>Sections 1 to 6 of this act shall be known and may be</u> |
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| 2 | cited as the Law Enforcement Attraction and Retention Act. |
| 3 | Sec. 2. <u>(1) The Legislature finds that:</u> |
| 4 | (a) The State of Nebraska and cities and counties in this state have |
| 5 | experienced a dramatic decrease in applications for law enforcement |
| 6 | officer positions; |
| 7 | <u>(b) Law enforcement officers in Nebraska are leaving the law</u> |
| 8 | enforcement profession; |
| 9 | (c) Law enforcement agencies are not retaining law enforcement |
| 10 | officers at a rate sufficient to ensure public safety; |
| 11 | (d) Law enforcement officers are the critical element of public |
| 12 | <u>safety in Nebraska communities; and</u> |
| 13 | <u>(e) Maintaining a robust law enforcement workforce is in the best</u> |
| 14 | <u>interests of all Nebraskans.</u> |
| 15 | (2) The purpose of the Law Enforcement Attraction and Retention Act |
| 16 | is to provide financial incentives to attract and retain law enforcement |
| 17 | <u>officers.</u> |
| 18 | Sec. 3. <u>(1) The Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council shall</u> |
| 19 | accept applications for incentive payments from individual law |
| 20 | <u>enforcement officers in Nebraska.</u> |
| 21 | (2) To be eligible for a tier 1 incentive payment, a law enforcement |
| 22 | officer must have begun his or her employment as a law enforcement |
| 23 | officer on or after the effective date of this act and must have |
| 24 | completed twelve months of employment as a law enforcement officer. The |
| 25 | tier 1 incentive payment shall be equal to one thousand dollars. No law |
| 26 | enforcement officer shall receive more than one tier 1 incentive payment. |
| 27 | (3) To be eligible for a tier 2 incentive payment, a law enforcement |
| 28 | officer must have begun his or her employment as a law enforcement |
| 29 | officer on or after the effective date of this act and must have |
| 30 | completed five years of employment as a law enforcement officer. The tier |
| 31 | 2 incentive payment shall be equal to two thousand dollars. No law |

| 1 | enforcement officer shall receive more than one tier 2 incentive payment. |
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| 2 | Sec. 4. (1) The Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council shall |
| 3 | accept applications for grants from law enforcement agencies in Nebraska. |
| 4 | The grants shall be used to provide hiring bonuses to newly hired law |
| 5 | <u>enforcement officers.</u> |
| 6 | <u>(2) A law enforcement agency shall be eligible for a grant under</u> |
| 7 | this section if: |
| 8 | <u>(a) The law enforcement agency is not at the recommended level of</u> |
| 9 | staffing under standards set by the council; or |
| 10 | (b) The law enforcement agency experiences a twenty percent loss of |
| 11 | law enforcement officers during the most recently completed fiscal year |
| 12 | or a thirty-three percent loss of law enforcement officers over the |
| 13 | course of the three most recently completed fiscal years. |
| 14 | Sec. 5. <u>The Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council may adopt</u> |
| 15 | and promulgate rules and regulations to carry out the Law Enforcement |
| 16 | Attraction and Retention Act. |
| 17 | Sec. 6. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate ten |
| 18 | million dollars each fiscal year to the Nebraska Police Standards |
| 19 | Advisory Council for purposes of carrying out the Law Enforcement |
| 20 | Attraction and Retention Act. |
