- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to law enforcement; to adopt the Law
- 2 Enforcement Marketing Act.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Sections 1 to 4 of this act shall be known and may be
- 2 <u>cited as the Law Enforcement Marketing Act.</u>
- 3 Sec. 2. The Legislature finds that:
- 4 (1) The State of Nebraska and cities and counties in this state have
- 5 <u>experienced a dramatic decrease in applications for law enforcement</u>
- 6 officer positions;
- 7 (2) Law enforcement officers in Nebraska are leaving the law
- 8 enforcement profession;
- 9 (3) Law enforcement agencies are not retaining law enforcement
- 10 officers at a rate sufficient to ensure public safety;
- 11 (4) Law enforcement officers are the critical element of public
- 12 safety in Nebraska communities;
- 13 (5) Maintaining a robust law enforcement workforce is in the best
- 14 <u>interests of all Nebraskans;</u>
- 15 (6) Opportunities exist to hire experienced law enforcement officers
- 16 from other states; and
- 17 <u>(7) Hiring experienced law enforcement officers from other states</u>
- 18 would be beneficial to Nebraska.
- 19 Sec. 3. (1) The Law Enforcement Marketing Program is created. The
- 20 Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council shall administer the program.
- 21 (2) Under the program, the Nebraska Police Standards Advisory
- 22 Council shall market and promote law enforcement job opportunities in
- 23 this state to law enforcement officers from other states in order to
- 24 encourage such officers to relocate to Nebraska.
- 25 (3)(a) The Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council shall create a
- 26 subcommittee to advise the council in matters relating to the program.
- 27 <u>The subcommittee shall include:</u>
- 28 <u>(i) A member of a national organization representing police</u>
- 29 <u>officers;</u>
- 30 (ii) A member of an organization representing police officers in a
- 31 city of the metropolitan class;

1 (iii) A member of an organization representing police officers in a

- 2 city of the primary class;
- 3 (iv) A member of an organization representing police chiefs in this
- 4 state;
- 5 <u>(v) A member of an organization representing sheriffs in this state;</u>
- 6 (vi) Two members of the Nebraska Police Standards Advisory Council;
- 7 and
- 8 (vii) A member representing the office of the Attorney General.
- 9 (b) The members of the subcommittee shall serve without
- 10 compensation, but they shall be entitled to receive reimbursement for
- 11 <u>expenses incurred incident to such service as provided in sections</u>
- 12 <u>81-1174 to 81-1177.</u>
- Sec. 4. It is the intent of the Legislature to appropriate one
- 14 million dollars each fiscal year to the Nebraska Police Standards
- 15 Advisory Council for purposes of carrying out the Law Enforcement
- 16 Marketing Act.
