4 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 69-2436, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
 amended to read:

3 69-2436 (1) A permit to carry a concealed handgun is valid 4 throughout the state for a period of five years after the date of 5 issuance. The fee for issuing a permit is one hundred dollars.

(2) The Nebraska State Patrol shall renew a permitholder's person's 6 7 permit to carry a concealed handgun for a renewal period of five years, subject to continuing compliance with the requirements of section 8 9 69-2433, except as provided in subsection (4) of section 69-2443. The renewal fee is fifty dollars, and renewal may be applied for no earlier 10 11 than up to four months before expiration of the a permit and no later than thirty business days after the date of expiration of the permit to 12 13 carry a concealed handgun.

(3) The applicant shall submit the fee with the application to the
Nebraska State Patrol. The fee shall be remitted to the State Treasurer
for credit to the Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund.

17 (4) On or before June 30, 2007, the Nebraska State Patrol shall
 18 journal entry, as necessary, all current fiscal year expenses and
 19 revenue, including investment income, from the Public Safety Cash Fund
 20 under the Concealed Handgun Permit Act and recode them against the
 21 Nebraska State Patrol Cash Fund and its program appropriation.

Sec. 2. Original section 69-2436, Reissue Revised Statutes of
Nebraska, is repealed.
