1 Section 1. Section 76-1423, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 3 76-1423 (1) The tenant shall not unreasonably withhold consent to
- 4 the landlord to enter into the dwelling unit in order to inspect the
- 5 premises, make necessary or agreed repairs, decorations, alterations, or
- 6 improvements, supply necessary or agreed services, or exhibit the
- 7 dwelling unit to prospective or actual purchasers, mortgagees, tenants,
- 8 workmen, or contractors.
- 9 (2) The landlord may enter the dwelling unit without consent of the
- 10 tenant in case of emergency.
- 11 (3) The landlord shall not abuse the right of access or use it to
- 12 harass the tenant. Except in case of emergency or if it is impracticable
- 13 to do so, the landlord shall:
- 14 <u>(a) Give give</u> the tenant at least <u>twenty-four hours' written</u> one
- 15 day's notice of the landlord's his intent to enter. Such notice shall be
- 16 provided to each individual unit and include the intended purpose for
- 17 entry and a reasonable period during which the landlord anticipates
- 18 <u>making entry;</u> and
- 19 <u>(b) Enter enter only at reasonable times; and</u> -
- 20 (c) Obtain consent from at least one tenant before entering.
- 21 (4) The landlord has no other right of access except by court order,
- 22 and as permitted by subsection (2) of section 76-1432, or if the tenant
- 23 has abandoned or surrendered the premises.
