## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 378**

Introduced by DeBoer, 10. Read first time January 13, 2021 Committee: Education

- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to schools; to require the Commissioner of
- 2 Education to report data as prescribed.
- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

| 1  | Section 1. <u>On or before September 1, 2022, and on or before</u>               |
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| 2  | September 1 of each year thereafter, the Commissioner of Education shall         |
| 3  | provide a summary report of the public school data to the Clerk of the           |
| 4  | Legislature, the Legislative Fiscal Analyst, each member of the Education        |
| 5  | <u>Committee of the Legislature, and each member of the Revenue Committee of</u> |
| 6  | the Legislature. The report shall consist of data from the most recently         |
| 7  | <u>available complete data year as defined in section 79-1003 for each</u>       |
| 8  | school district and shall be submitted in an electronic format that              |
| 9  | allows the data to be sorted and rearranged. The report shall include:           |
| 10 | (1) The general fund operating expenditures;                                     |
| 11 | (2) The percentage change in the general fund operating expenditures             |
| 12 | for the most recently available complete data year compared to the school        |
| 13 | fiscal year immediately preceding the most recently available complete           |
| 14 | <u>data year;</u>  |
| 15 | (3) The total equalization aid received pursuant to section                      |
| 16 | <u>79-1008.01;</u>   |
| 17 | (4) The total funds collected through property taxes;                            |
| 18 | (5) The total amount of special education reimbursements received                |
| 19 | pursuant to section 79-1142;   |
| 20 | (6) The total revenue collected by the district;                                 |
| 21 | <u>(7) The percentage change in the revenue collected for the most</u>           |
| 22 | recently available complete data year compared to the school fiscal year         |
| 23 | immediately preceding the most recently available complete data year;            |
| 24 | (8) The total special education expenditures funded by state and                 |
| 25 | <u>local sources;</u>  |
| 26 | <u>(9) The percentage change in the total special education</u>                  |
| 27 | expenditures funded by state and local sources for the most recently             |
| 28 | <u>available complete data year compared to the school fiscal year</u>           |
| 29 | immediately preceding the most recently available complete data year;            |
| 30 | <u>(10) The fall membership;</u>   |
| 31 | (11) The general fund operating expenditures divided by the fall                 |

- 1 <u>membership;</u>
- 2 (12) The annual depreciation for school district buildings and the 3 contents of such buildings;
- 4 <u>(13) The number of poverty students used to determine the poverty</u>
- 5 <u>allowance pursuant to section 79-1007.06; and</u>
- 6 (14) The number of students in the school district who are limited
- 7 English proficient as described in subdivision (2)(b)(i) of section
