- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to teachers; to amend section 79-813, Reissue
- 2 Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to require the issuance of
- 3 certificates and permits to military spouses as prescribed; to
- 4 harmonize provisions; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. Section 79-813, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is

- 2 amended to read:
- 3 79-813 (1)(a) The board shall authorize the issuance of a
- 4 certificate or permit to any applicant for such certificate or permit
- 5 <u>who:</u>
- 6 (i) Is a military spouse;
- 7 (ii) Holds a valid certificate or permit currently in force in
- 8 <u>another state to teach, administer, or provide special services;</u>
- 9 (iii) Has held such certificate or permit for at least one year;
- 10 (iv) Is in good standing in all states where a certificate or permit
- 11 to teach, administer, or provide special services is held;
- 12 <u>(v) Does not have any pending investigations or complaints against</u>
- 13 any such certificate or permit;
- 14 (vi) Meets all residency and background check requirements otherwise
- 15 required for a Nebraska certificate or permit; and
- 16 <u>(vii) Pays any applicable fees.</u>
- 17 <u>(b) The commissioner shall verify that the applicant for a</u>
- 18 <u>certificate or permit under this subsection meets the requirements of</u>
- 19 subdivisions (a)(iv) and (v) of this subsection. Such applicant shall not
- 20 <u>be required to meet the human relations training requirement under</u>
- 21 section 79-808 to obtain such certification or permit. Such certificate
- 22 or permit shall be valid for at least three years and shall include the
- 23 same or similar endorsements to teach in all subject areas for which the
- 24 applicant had been certified to teach in such other state if a similar
- 25 endorsement is offered in Nebraska.
- 26 <u>(c) A preliminary permit shall be issued to an applicant upon</u>
- 27 submission of the application, payment of the applicable fees, and the
- 28 successful completion of the criminal history record information check as
- 29 provided in section 79-814.01. The preliminary permit shall remain in
- 30 force until the commissioner completes the review of all requirements in
- 31 subdivision (1)(a) of this section and either issues a certificate or

1 permit or notifies the applicant of the reason such certificate or permit

- 2 <u>cannot be issued.</u>
- 3 (d) The board shall adopt and promulgate rules and regulations to
- 4 (i) expedite the processing of an application submitted under this
- 5 <u>subsection by an applicant whose spouse is serving on active duty at the</u>
- 6 time of such submission and (ii) specify the documentation necessary to
- 7 establish the applicant's status as a spouse of a person who is serving
- 8 <u>on active duty at the time of such submission.</u>
- 9 <u>(e) For purposes of this subsection:</u>
- 10 (i) Active duty means full-time duty status in the active uniformed
- 11 <u>service of the United States, including members of the National Guard and</u>
- 12 Reserve on active duty orders pursuant to 10 U.S.C. 1209 and 1211; and
- 13 (ii) Military spouse has the same meaning as in section 38-118.01.
- 14 (2) In addition to certificates and permits issued pursuant to
- 15 <u>subsection (1) of this section, the</u> The board may authorize the issuance
- 16 of certificates or permits to applicants who hold a valid certificate or
- 17 permit currently in force in another a state other than Nebraska if the
- 18 requirements for the certificate or permit held by the applicant are
- 19 comparable and equivalent to those required for a similar type of
- 20 certificate or permit issued under sections 79-806 to 79-815.
