- 1 Section 1. Section 68-1735, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 68-1735 (1) For purposes of creating the self-sufficiency contract
- 4 and meeting the applicant's work activity requirement, an applicant who
- 5 is under twenty years of age and is married or a single head of household
- 6 is deemed to have met the work activity requirement in a month if the
- 7 applicant he or she:
- 8 (a) (1) Maintains satisfactory attendance during such month at
- 9 secondary school, a general education development program, or the
- 10 equivalent; or
- 11 $\frac{\text{(b)}}{\text{(2)}}$ Participates in education directly related to employment for
- 12 an average of at least twenty hours per week during such month. Education
- 13 directly related to employment includes, but is not limited to, Adult
- 14 Basic Education, English as a Second Language, and a general education
- 15 development program.
- 16 (2) An applicant shall be permitted to complete the monthly work
- 17 activity requirements through remote or online course work, including
- 18 coursework over the Internet, in any educational program that would
- 19 <u>otherwise qualify as an activity enumerated under subsection (1) of</u>
- 20 <u>section 68-1735.02.</u>
- 21 (3) For applicants engaged in remote or online course work permitted
- 22 under subsection (2) of this section, the Department of Health and Human
- 23 Services shall utilize self-attestation to verify participation. The
- 24 <u>department shall be permitted to review or audit the information provided</u>
- 25 by the applicant to confirm the required participation if the information
- 26 provided by the applicant in a self-attestation is questionable.
