- 4 active duty, other than members of the National Guard or reserves
- 5 activated for training purposes only, outside the State of Nebraska as a
- 6 member of the United States Armed Forces, or the spouse of any such
- 7 person or a dependent of such member of the armed forces, shall be valid
- 8 during the such person's period of active duty and for not more than
- 9 sixty days immediately following the such person's date of separation
- 10 from service for: -
- 11 (a) A person serving on active duty, other than a member of the
- 12 <u>National Guard or reserves activated for training purposes only, outside</u>
- 13 the State of Nebraska as a member of the United States Armed Forces;
- 14 (b) An officer of the foreign service of the United States;
- (c) The spouse of a person described in subdivision (a) or (b) of
- 16 this section; and
- 17 <u>(d) The dependent of a person described in subdivision (a) or (b) of</u>
- 18 this section.
- 19 (2) Each individual who is applying for renewal of his or her
- 20 operator's license shall submit his or her previous license to the
- 21 department personnel or, when the previous license is unavailable,
- 22 furnish proof of identification in accordance with section 60-484.
