- 3 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. (1) This section shall be known and may be cited as the

- 2 <u>Social Media Fairness Act.</u>
- 3 (2) For purposes of the Social Media Fairness Act, dominant social
- 4 media web site means an Internet web site or application through which a
- 5 <u>user creates, shares, and interacts with content, including videos, still</u>
- 6 photographs, blogs, video blogs, podcasts, instant or text messages,
- 7 emails, online services or accounts, or Internet web site profiles or
- 8 <u>locations</u>, which has more than seventy-five million subscribers or users,
- 9 and was not specifically affiliated with any one religion or political
- 10 party from its inception.
- 11 (3) If an individual or business user that is a resident of this
- 12 state has a dominant social media web site account disabled, suspended,
- 13 or censored by a dominant social media web site, the owner or operator of
- 14 the dominate social media web site must provide electronic notice to such
- individual or business user within thirty days after taking such action.
- 16 The notice must be in writing and must adequately explain why the
- 17 individual or business user's account was suspended, disabled, or
- 18 censored. If the owner or operator of the dominant social media web site
- 19 would have violated the First Amendment had the owner or operator of the
- 20 <u>dominant social media web site been a government actor, the owner or</u>
- 21 operator of the dominant social media company shall be fined one hundred
- 22 thousand dollars per violation. Such action for a fine shall be initiated
- 23 and collected by the Attorney General.
- 24 (4) All fines collected by the Attorney General pursuant to this
- 25 section shall be remitted to the State Treasurer for distribution in
- 26 <u>accordance with Article VII, section 5, Constitution of Nebraska.</u>
