 provisions relating to public buildings and when a vote of the
 electors is required; and to repeal the original section.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. Section 16-6,100, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
 2020, is amended to read:

3 16-6,100 The mayor and city council of a city of the first class shall have the power to borrow money and pledge the property and credit 4 of the city upon its negotiable bonds or otherwise for the purpose of 5 acquiring, by purchasing or constructing, including site acquisition, or 6 aiding in the acquiring of a city hall, jail, auditorium, buildings for 7 the fire department, and other public buildings, including the 8 9 acquisition of buildings authorized to be acquired by Chapter 72, article 14, and including acquisition of buildings to be leased in whole or in 10 part by the city to any other political or governmental subdivision of 11 the State of Nebraska authorized by law to lease such buildings. No such 12 bonds shall be issued until after the same have been authorized by a 13 majority vote of the electors of the city voting on the proposition of 14 their issuance at an election called for the submission of such 15 proposition and of which election notice of the time and place thereof 16 shall have been given by publication in a legal newspaper in or of 17 general circulation in the city three successive weeks prior thereto. If 18 the <u>buildings</u> building to be acquired are is to be used by the State of 19 Nebraska or its agency or agencies under a lease authorized by Chapter 20 72, article 14, or the <u>buildings are building is</u> to be leased by any 21 other political or governmental subdivision of the State of Nebraska or 22 23 other governmental agencies and if the combined area of the buildings 24 building to be leased by the state or its agency or agencies and the political or governmental subdivision of the State of Nebraska is more 25 than fifty percent of the area of the buildings building and if the cost 26 of acquisition does not exceed five two million dollars, no such vote of 27 the electors will be required. 28
