- 1 A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to claims against the state; to appropriate
- 2 funds for the payment of certain claims; to provide for payment of
- 3 the claims; to authorize agencies to write off certain claims as
- 4 prescribed; and to declare an emergency.
- 5 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

1 Section 1. The following sums of money, or so much thereof as may

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- 2 <u>be required</u>, are hereby appropriated from the General Fund or from other
- 3 <u>funds as indicated in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, for</u>
- 4 the payment of claims arising out of miscellaneous items of indebtedness
- 5 <u>owing by the State of Nebraska.</u>

- 16 authorized and directed to draw his or her warrants upon the funds in the
- 17 state treasury enumerated in this act, in favor of the several
- 18 beneficiaries named in this act for the amount set opposite their
- 19 respective names, upon the presentation of proper vouchers therefor. The
- 20 several amounts appropriated in this act shall be in full payment of any
- 21 and all claims, rights, causes of action, damages, and demands of every
- 22 <u>character and kind owing by or against the State of Nebraska, its</u>
- 23 officers, agents, and employees, and their successors and assigns with
- 24 respect to each of the beneficiaries respectively in whose favor the
- 25 appropriations are made. The director shall not deliver any warrant for
- 26 any items appropriated in this act until a receipt and release in full,
- 27 releasing the State of Nebraska, its officers, employees, and agents, and
- 28 their successors and assigns, has been filed by each of the beneficiaries
- 29 respectively. Upon presentation of the warrants, the State Treasurer is
- 30 <u>hereby directed to pay the same out of money in the General Fund or out</u>
- 31 <u>of money in other funds indicated in this act not otherwise appropriated.</u>
