## **LEGISLATIVE BILL 705**

- A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to the Barber Act; to amend sections 71-201, 71-208.02, and 71-219, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska; to
- 3 eliminate provisions relating to booth rental permits; to change
- 4 requirements for registration as a barber instructor or assistant
- 5 barber instructor; to harmonize provisions; to repeal the original
- 6 sections; and to outright repeal section 71-219.05, Reissue Revised
- 7 Statutes of Nebraska.
- 8 Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

- 1 Section 1. Section 71-201, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 2 amended to read:
- 3 71-201 (1) No person shall practice or attempt to practice
- 4 barbering without a license issued pursuant to the Barber Act by the
- 5 board. It shall be unlawful to operate a barber shop unless it is at all
- 6 times under the direct supervision and management of a licensed barber.
- 7 (2)(a) No person, partnership, limited liability company, or
- 8 corporation shall operate a barber shop or barber school until a license
- 9 has been obtained for that purpose from the board. If the applicant is an
- 10 individual, the application shall include the applicant's social security
- 11 number. No person shall lease space on the premises of a barber shop to
- 12 engage in the practice of barbering as an independent contractor or a
- 13 self-employed person without obtaining a booth rental permit as provided
- 14 in section 71-219.05. All barber shop licenses and booth rental permits
- 15 shall be issued on or before June 30 of each even-numbered year, shall be
- 16 effective as of July 1 of each even-numbered year, shall be valid for two
- 17 years, and shall expire on June 30 of the next succeeding even-numbered
- 18 year.
- 19 <u>(b) No booth rental permits shall be required after the effective</u>
- 20 <u>date of this act.</u>
- 21 (3) Any barber shop which fails to renew its license or any person
- 22 who fails to renew his or her booth rental permit on or before the
- 23 expiration date may renew such license or booth rental permit by payment
- 24 of the renewal fee and a late renewal fee established by the board within
- 25 sixty days after such date or such other time period as the board
- 26 establishes.
- 27 <u>(4) Any barber shop or barber school license and any booth rental</u>
- 28 permit may be suspended, revoked, or denied renewal by the board for
- 29 violation of any provision of the statutes or any rule or regulation of
- 30 the board pertaining to the operation or sanitation of barber shops or au
- 31 barber schools<del>, or booths under a booth rental permit</del> after due notice

- 1 and hearing before the board.
- 2 (5) No person, partnership, limited liability company, or
- 3 corporation shall use the title of barber or barber shop or indicate in
- 4 any way that such person or entity offers barbering services unless such
- 5 person or entity is licensed pursuant to the act. No person, partnership,
- 6 limited liability company, or corporation shall hold itself out as a
- 7 barber shop or indicate in any way that such person or entity offers
- 8 barbering services unless such person or entity and the personnel who
- 9 purport to offer barbering services in association with such person or
- 10 entity are licensed pursuant to the act.
- 11 <u>(6)</u> No person, partnership, limited liability company, or
- 12 corporation shall display a barber pole or use a barber pole or the image
- 13 of a barber pole in its advertising unless such person or entity is
- 14 licensed to provide barbering services pursuant to the act and the
- 15 display or use of such barber pole or barber pole image is to indicate
- 16 that the person or entity is offering barbering services.
- 17 Sec. 2. Section 71-208.02, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 18 amended to read:
- 19 71-208.02 (1) All instruction in barber schools shall be conducted
- 20 by registered barber instructors or registered assistant barber
- 21 instructors.
- 22 (2) A person shall be eligible for registration as a barber
- 23 instructor if:
- 24 (a) He or she has completed at least eighteen hours of college
- 25 credit at or above the postsecondary level, including at least three
- 26 credit hours each in (i) methods of teaching, (ii) curriculum
- 27 development, (iii) special vocational needs, (iv) educational psychology,
- 28 (v) speech communications, and (vi) introduction to business;
- 29 (b) He or she has been a licensed and actively practicing barber for
- 30 the one year immediately preceding application, except that for good
- 31 cause the board may waive the requirement that the applicant be an

1 actively practicing barber for one year or that such year immediately

- 2 precede application;
- 3 (c) He or she has served as a registered assistant barber instructor
- 4 under the supervision of an active, full-time, registered barber
- 5 instructor, as provided in subsection (5) of this section, for <u>nine</u>
- 6 months one year immediately preceding application for registration,
- 7 except that for good cause the board may waive the requirement that such
- 8 nine-month period year immediately precede application;
- 9 (d) He or she has passed an examination prescribed by the board; and
- 10 (e) He or she has paid the fees prescribed by section 71-219.
- 11 (3) One registered barber instructor or assistant barber instructor
- 12 shall be employed for each fifteen students, or fraction thereof,
- 13 enrolled in a barber school, except that each barber school shall have
- 14 not less than two instructors, one of whom shall be a registered barber
- 15 instructor, regardless of the number of students. Additional assistant
- 16 barber instructors shall be permitted on a working ratio of two assistant
- 17 barber instructors for every registered barber instructor. A barber
- 18 school operated by a nonprofit organization which neither charges any
- 19 tuition to its students nor makes any charge to the persons upon whom
- 20 work is performed shall not be required to have more than one instructor,
- 21 regardless of the number of students, which instructor shall be a
- 22 registered barber instructor.
- 23 (4) No student at a barber school shall be permitted to do any
- 24 practical work upon any person unless a registered barber instructor or
- 25 registered assistant barber instructor is on the premises and supervising
- 26 the practical work being performed.
- 27 (5)(a) A person shall be eligible for registration as an assistant
- 28 barber instructor if he or she has paid the fee prescribed by section
- 29 71-219, has been a licensed and actively practicing barber for one year,
- 30 and is currently enrolled or will enroll at the first regular college
- 31 enrollment date after registration under this section in an educational

1 program leading to completion of the hours required under subsection (2)

- 2 of this section.
- 3 (b) A person registered pursuant to subdivision (a) of this
- 4 subsection shall serve as an assistant barber instructor under direct
- 5 supervision, except that he or she may serve as an assistant barber
- 6 instructor under indirect supervision if:
- 7 (i) He or she has completed nine college credit hours, including
- 8 three credit hours each in methods of teaching, curriculum development,
- 9 and special vocational needs; and
- 10 (ii) He or she has completed <u>nine months</u> <del>one year</del> of instructor
- 11 training under the direct inhouse supervision of an active, full-time,
- 12 registered barber instructor or in lieu thereof has completed the
- 13 requirements of a barber instructor course developed or approved by the
- 14 board. The board may develop such courses or approve courses developed by
- 15 educational institutions or other entities which meet requirements
- 16 established by the board in rules and regulations.
- 17 (c) A report of college credits earned pursuant to subsection (2) of
- 18 this section shall be submitted to the board at the end of each academic
- 19 year. Registration as an assistant barber instructor shall be renewed in
- 20 each even-numbered year and shall be valid for three years from the date
- 21 of registration if the registrant pursues without interruption the
- 22 educational program described in subsection (2) of this section. A
- 23 registrant who fails to so maintain such program shall have his or her
- 24 registration revoked. Any such registration that has been revoked shall
- 25 be reinstated if all renewal fees have been paid and other registration
- 26 requirements of this subsection are met.
- 27 (6) A person who is a registered barber instructor before September
- 28 9, 1993, may continue to practice as a registered barber instructor on
- 29 and after such date without meeting the changes in the registration
- 30 requirements of this section imposed by Laws 1993, LB 226. A person who
- 31 is a registered assistant barber instructor before September 9, 1993, and

- 1 who seeks to register as a barber instructor on or after September 9,
- 2 1993, may meet the requirements for registration as a barber instructor
- 3 either as such requirements existed before such date or as such
- 4 requirements exist on or after such date.
- 5 Sec. 3. Section 71-219, Reissue Revised Statutes of Nebraska, is
- 6 amended to read:
- 7 71-219 The board shall set the fees to be paid:
- 8 (1) By an applicant for an examination to determine his or her
- 9 fitness to receive a license to practice barbering or a registration as a
- 10 barber instructor and for the issuance of the license or registration;
- 11 (2) By an applicant for registration as an assistant barber
- 12 instructor;
- 13 (3) For the renewal of a license to practice barbering and for
- 14 restoration of an inactive license;
- 15 (4) For the renewal of a registration to practice as a barber
- 16 instructor and for the restoration of an inactive registration;
- 17 (5) For renewal of a registration to practice as an assistant barber
- 18 instructor;
- 19 (6) For late renewal of a license issued under the Barber Act;
- 20 (7) For an application for a license to establish a barber shop or
- 21 barber school and for the issuance of a license;
- 22 (8) For the transfer of license or change of ownership of a barber
- 23 shop or barber school;
- 24 (9) For renewal of a barber license, barber instructor registration,
- 25 barber shop license, or barber school license;
- 26 (10) For an application for a temporary license to conduct classes
- 27 of instruction in barbering;
- 28 (11) For an affidavit for purposes of reciprocity or for issuance of
- 29 a certification of licensure for purposes of reciprocity;
- 30 (12) For an application for licensure without examination pursuant
- 31 to section 71-239.01 and for the issuance of a license pursuant to such

- 1 section;
- 2 (13) For issuance of a booth rental permit under section 71-219.05;
- 3 (13) (14) For the sale of listings or labels; and
- 4 (14) For a returned check because of insufficient funds or no
- 5 funds.
- 6 Sec. 4. Original sections 71-201, 71-208.02, and 71-219, Reissue
- 7 Revised Statutes of Nebraska, are repealed.
