1 Section 1. Laws 2021, LB380, section 104, is amended to read:

17 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program  
18 \$653,759 General Funds for FY2021-22 and \$653,759 General Funds for  
19 FY2022-23, which shall only be used for the following purposes:  
20 Reimbursement for the provision of pap smears, colposcopy, cervical  
21 biopsy, cryotherapy, loop electrosurgical excision procedure (LEEP), and  
22 such other treatments and procedures as may be developed for the followup  
23 of abnormal pap smears; the diagnosis and treatment of sexually  
24 transmitted diseases, including, but not limited to, chlamydia,  
25 gonorrhoea, HPV (genital warts), and herpes; and associated laboratory and  
26 equipment costs and staff training costs relating to the use of  
27 colposcopy equipment. None of the General Funds provided under this  
28 program shall be used to perform or facilitate the performance of  
29 abortion or to counsel or refer for abortion.

30 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for  
31 FY2021-22 \$200,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund for

1 the Poison Control Center at the University of Nebraska Medical Center,  
2 which shall only be used by the medical center for the Poison Control  
3 Center. There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for  
4 FY2022-23 \$200,000 Cash Funds from the Nebraska Health Care Cash Fund for

18 based early intervention home visitation programs.

19 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for  
20 FY2021-22 up to \$100,000 General Funds to contract with the University of  
21 Nebraska Medical Center for the Nebraska Perinatal Quality Improvement  
22 Collaborative. There is included in the amount shown as aid for this  
23 program for FY2022-23 up to ~~\$200,000~~ ~~\$100,000~~ General Funds to contract  
24 with the University of Nebraska Medical Center for the Nebraska Perinatal  
25 Quality Improvement Collaborative.

26 There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for  
27 FY2021-22 \$289,416 General Funds to contract for services for  
28 implementation of a statewide drug disposal project. There is included in  
29 the amount shown as aid for this program for FY2022-23 \$289,416 General  
30 Funds to contract for services for implementation of a statewide drug  
31 disposal project.

1           There is included in the amount shown as aid for this program for
