**Introducer's Statement of Intent**

The following constitutes the reasons for this bill and the purposes which are sought to be accomplished thereby:

LB714 proposes to reallocate fees for five year documents issued by the Department of Motor Vehicles to create a funding mechanism to streamline the business model for delivering driver licensing services by establishing a Lancaster County Service Center. The current location in Lancaster County is not adequate to serve the needs of the over 100,000 customers each year. The bill redistributes \$3.00 from the issuance of the Five-Year Class O License, M License, and State Identification Card from the State General Fund to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund. There will be no increase in fees to the customer.
