

LEGISLATIVE BILL 108A

Passed over the Governor's veto May 26, 2021.

Introduced by McCollister, 20.

A BILL FOR AN ACT relating to appropriations; to appropriate funds to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 108, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021; and to declare an emergency.
Be it enacted by the people of the State of Nebraska,

Section 1. There is hereby appropriated (1) \$49,153 from federal funds for FY2020-21, (2) \$457,176 from federal funds for FY2021-22, and (3) \$443,339 from federal funds for FY2022-23 to the Department of Health and Human Services, for Program 33, to aid in carrying out the provisions of Legislative Bill 108, One Hundred Seventh Legislature, First Session, 2021.

Total expenditures for permanent and temporary salaries and per diems from funds appropriated in this section shall not exceed \$18,495 for FY2020-21, \$294,986 for FY2021-22, or \$296,573 for FY2022-23.

Sec. 2. Since an emergency exists, this act takes effect when passed and approved according to law.
