(1) Beginning in school year 2025-26 through school year 2030-31, a student shall be entitled to a waiver of one hundred percent 4 5 of the resident tuition charges of the University of Nebraska or a 6 Nebraska state college for student teaching during the semester the student is student teaching in a Nebraska elementary, middle, or high 7 8 school if the student: 9 (a) Is enrolled at the University of Nebraska or a Nebraska state 10 college; (b) Is taking classes and pursuing a degree that relates to a career 11 12 in teaching; and 13 (c) Maintains satisfactory academic performance at the University of Nebraska or the Nebraska state college. 14 (2)(a) Beginning in school year 2025-26 through school year 2031-32, 15 during the semester in which a student who meets the requirements of 16 subsection (1) of this section is student teaching, the University of 17 Nebraska or the Nebraska state college shall waive one hundred percent of 18 the student's tuition for student teaching remaining due after 19 20 subtracting for such semester any (i) awarded federal financial aid 21 grants, (ii) awarded state scholarships and grants, and (iii) stipend paid to such student for student teaching. 22 (b) The University of Nebraska or the Nebraska state college shall 23 annually submit a report electronically to the Clerk of the Legislature 24 relating to the number of students receiving the waivers described in 25

26 <u>subdivision (2)(a) of this section and the total amount of each tuition</u>

27 waiver granted pursuant to this subsection. Such report shall not contain
