- 3 Section 1. Section 85-505, Revised Statutes Cumulative Supplement,
- 4 2022, is amended to read:

5 85-505 Any member of the Nebraska National Guard who enrolls in any college, or community college or 6 state-supported university, 7 independent, not-for-profit, accredited college or university in this state shall be entitled to a credit of one hundred percent of the 8 resident tuition charges of such school for a diploma, certificate, 9 associate degree, or baccalaureate degree program or fifty percent of the 10 resident tuition charges of such school for a graduate or professional 11 degree program, except that any member who attends an independent, not-12 13 for-profit, accredited college or university in this state shall receive a credit in an amount no higher than such member would receive if 14 attending the University of Nebraska-Lincoln. Such entitlement shall, 15 subject to the requirements of sections 85-505 to 85-508, continue for as 16 long as the member maintains satisfactory performance with the guard and 17 pursues a course of study in such institution in a manner which satisfies 18 the normal requirements of the institution. The number of individuals 19 20 granted tuition credit shall not exceed the number specified in section 85-505.01 during any fiscal year, and the amount of tuition credits 21 granted shall not exceed nine hundred thousand dollars during any fiscal 22 year. When determining to whom such tuition credit shall be awarded, 23 priority shall be given to those individuals who have previously received 24 tuition credits while a National Guard member, and the Nebraska National 25 Guard shall apply those program qualifications and limitations consistent 26 27 with efficient and effective program management as determined by the
