Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 1359 requires any city of the metropolitan class to put the issue before the registered voters for any bond or series of bonds for a specific project in excess of eighty million dollars (\$80,000,000).

Section-by-Section Summary:

Section 1 amends Neb. Rev. Stat. 14-527 to change requirements for issuance of bonds in a city of the metropolitan class. Here, a vote of registered voters shall be required for any bond or series of bonds for a particular project that would exceed \$80 million.

Section 2 repeals the original section.
