Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Summary:

This bill would change the official time in Nebraska to remain on Daylight Savings Time year-round. However, this change is contingent on a federal law or policy change and adoption of "single year-round standard of time" by three adjacent states.

In the meantime, this bill would adjust the start and end dates for Daylight Savings Time (DST). Under this bill, the start of DST would be moved from the first Sunday in April to the second Sunday in March. The end of DST would move from the last Sunday in October to the first Sunday in November. These changes to the start and end dates for DST would become null and void upon the year-round DST provisions becoming operative.
