## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Overview: LB 160 proposes to increase the contribution rates for required supplemental or auxiliary retirement plan for county law enforcement participating in County Employees Retirement Plan.

Section by section:

Section 1 Amends section 23-2332, addressing counties participating in the County Employees Retirement Plan with a population of more than 85,000, by increasing the contribution amount for commissioned law enforcement personnel. Both employer and employee would increase from two percent to three percent of compensation.

Section 2 Amends section 23-2332.01, addressing counties participating in the County Employees Retirement Plan with a population of less than 85,000, by increasing the contribution amount for commissioned law enforcement personnel. Both employer and employee would increase from one percent to two percent of compensation.

Section 3 Repeals original sections.
