Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Summary:

Legislative Bill 343 would require a certification in public contracts that contractors do not boycott Israel and will not do so for the term of the contract. Public entities would be prohibited from entering into a contract if that certification by the private provider is not included.

Any contract entered into in violation of the Act would be void as against public policy. The Department of Administrative Services (DAS) would be granted discretion to promulgate rules and regulations to effectuate the Act. The Act includes definitions for "boycott," "company," and "public entity," and provides that a statement by a company that the company is boycotting Israel would be considered as evidence that the company is boycotting Israel. The provisions of this bill would not apply to contracts with a value of less than one hundred thousand dollars, or to companies with fewer than ten employees.

The bill includes a severability clause.
