Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB427 would standardize the fees for in-state and out-of-state contractors and eliminate the additional fee for each additional project assessed against out-of-state contractors under the Contractor Registration Act. The additional non-resident contractor fee applies if the total contract price of compensation received would be higher than \$10,000. Neb. Sta. Rev. § 48-2107.

Section 1: Strikes the definition of non-resident contractor.

Section 2: Strikes the language requiring the non-resident contractor fee.
