Summary of purpose and/or changes:

Amends section 60-4,115; Allocation of Fees for Operators' Licenses and State Identification Cards.

Currently the statutory fees established for the issuance of state identification cards operators' licenses, replacement ignition interlock permits, and 24/7 sobriety program permits are allocated between the county general fund, the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund, and the State General Fund. The bill amends the section to provide that where any portion of the fee charged is allocated to the State General Fund, that amount is instead redirected and deposited to the Department of Motor Vehicles Cash Fund.

The bill does not increase the consumer's cost of any identification card, license, or permit.

LB 465 contains the Emergency Clause and is operative July 1, 2023.
