## Summary of purpose and/or changes:

This bill would prohibit county board members and county planning commission members and their immediate families from having either a direct or indirect financial interest in electric generation facilities. "Immediate family" would be defined to include spouse, child, sibling, parent, grandparent, or grandchild.

## Explanation of amendments:

AM 971 to LB 569

The committee amendment strikes the original sections. Instead of prohibiting persons with certain commercial interests from holding local elected office, the revised version of the bill would require that such interests be disclosed to the public via written notice and a public hearing.
