Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 632 would prohibit a school in a metropolitan class from suspending a student in Pre-K through 2nd grade. Each such school shall develop a policy to include disciplinary measures as an alternative to suspension.

Explanation of amendments:

Amendment 1208 prohibits the suspension of students enrolled in Pre-K through second grade.

Exceptions may exist if the student brings a deadly weapon on school grounds, or in a school vehicle, or to a school event or activity.
