Summary of purpose and/or changes:

LB 68 would amend a number of statutes found in the Nebraska Hospital-Medical Liability Act (Act). The bill would provide, section by section, as follows:

Sections 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6 will amend, respectively, Neb. Rev. Stat. 44-2824, 44-2825, 44-2827, 44-2832 and 44-2833 by increasing the coverage requirements from five hundred thousand dollars per occurrence to one million dollars per occurrence. It also increases the coverage requirements from one million dollars for all occurrences or claims made in any policy year or risk-loss year to three million dollars for all occurrences or claims made in any policy year or risk-loss year.

Section 4 amends Neb. Rev. Stat. 44-2831.01 by providing for a phase in period relating to the increased coverage requirements created by LB 68.

Section 7 states the operative date of LB 68.

Section 8 repeals the original sections being amended.
