Sec. 1: (1) Definitions:

(a) Division means the Division of Children and Family

Services DHHS

(b) Grant program means the Residential Youth Parenting

Facility Grant Program

- (c) Residential child-caring agency has the same meaning as in section 71-1926
- (2) The purpose of the grant program is to make grants available for construction of a facility for pregnant and parenting homeless youth.
- (3) A licensed residential child-caring agency currently providing street outreach services to homeless youth may apply to the division for a grant
- (4) If the residential child-caring agency fails to build such facility within 48 months after receiving the grant, the residential child-caring agency shall return all grant funds to the division
- (5) The fund shall consist of transfers made by the Legislature, funds returned under subsection (4) of this section, and any gifts, grants, bequests, or donations to the fund
 - (6) Appropriate \$2 million from the General Fund.
